## **Booking Terms and Conditions**

Booking with Mansell Raceway Ltd acknowledges acceptance of these terms and conditions.

#### Timings and Bookings

- All Race Events require pre-booking and are subject to availability.
- You will be required to provide a valid e-mail address at the time of booking as we will send you a confirmation of booking e-mail, which will include a copy of our booking terms and conditions.
- Arrival & Registration time is 45 minutes prior to the start time agreed in your confirmation of booking. Failure
  to arrive on time will result in a reduction of track time. At the discretion of the management, arriving more
  than 15 mins after the agreed start time will result in the event being cancelled with full payment, based on the
  minimum numbers detailed in your confirmation being due.
- All bookings are subject to a £1.50 booking fee.
- Bookings over the phone: At the time of booking, 50% of the balance is to be paid. The remaining 50% of the balance must be paid at least two weeks prior to the event. If it is not paid, we reserve the right to cancel the event with no refund for the initial 50% paid.
- Online bookings: At the time of booking, full payment is required.
- Deposit payments are transferable: see cancellation policy for refund information.
- Your deposit/full payment can be paid by cash in person at the track or via telephone payment.
- For track exclusivity, the minimum booking is for ten people.

#### Final Balance Payment

- At least two weeks prior to the event commencing, the balance payment, as detailed on the confirmation of booking, must be paid in full.
- The minimum billing, as detailed on the confirmation will be due even if fewer drivers turn up, take part or retire for any reason.
- Unless otherwise agreed, where full payment is not received at this time, Mansell Raceway Ltd reserve the right to cancel the event without refund of any deposits paid.
- The final payment for your event can be paid by cash in person at the track or via telephone payment by most major credit or debit cards. Payment by debit cards, cash or will not incur any surcharge. We do not accept cheques, unless agreed in advance by a manager at Mansell Raceway Ltd.

#### Cancellation

- If an event is cancelled more than 14 days prior to an event, then the deposit paid can be transferred to a new booking or refunded at the discretion of the management.
- At the discretion of the management, we may give a refund on the event payment.

#### Gift Vouchers

- Gift Vouchers can be purchased online, over the phone or in person at the track. If you are planning to come to the track, please contact us first to make sure that someone will be available to process your order.
- All Vouchers must be paid in full at Point of Sale by cash or credit / debit card only.
- All Vouchers are Non-refundable.
- Vouchers cannot be exchanged for Cash.
- Mansell Raceway Ltd does not accept Liability for Lost or Stolen Vouchers.
- All Vouchers are valid for 12 months from the Date of Issue.
- The Issue Date is usually the Purchase Date.
- In the case of Race Event Vouchers (i.e. Sprint etc), sessions must be pre-booked, and a Valid Voucher Code must be quoted at the time of booking (subject to availability).
- All Voucher codes must be submitted and validated at the time of booking.



### Participation Terms and Conditions

- For the enjoyment and safety of all drivers, you are advised of the following extracts from our "Rules of the Circuit". If you have any doubts about the following, please contact us directly for further information.
  - The Management or Race Director may refuse permission for any driver to compete/drive on the grounds of safety to others and/or themselves without refund of any money paid. Please make all drivers in your group fully aware of the following extracts from our "Rules of the Circuit".
  - The physical design and size of karts operated by Mansell Raceway Ltd may be a limiting factor for certain drivers.
    - Drivers should be a minimum of 14 years of age and over 1.4m tall to participate in arrive & drive sessions.
    - Drivers should be a minimum of 16 years of age and over 1.4m tall to participate race events.
  - The minimum height of 1.4m is not a guarantee that drivers can participate, all drivers must be able to reach the pedals safely. Drivers outside of the height and/or weight restrictions detailed above may not be permitted to drive and no refunds will be given. Any persons concerned by these limits are welcome to visit the centre before booking and check they can control the kart safely.
  - o Drivers under 18 years of age must be accompanied at all times by an adult over 18 years old.
  - Drivers must wear flat-soled shoes (e.g. training shoes). High heels, sandals, open toed shoes, platform soles are not permitted.
  - All drivers must attend the safety briefing. Late arrivals will not be permitted to drive and no refund will be issued.
  - Karting is not suitable for anyone with heart or breathing difficulties, back or neck problems, pregnant women or people with a nervous disposition.
  - Alcohol or drugs must not, under any circumstances, be consumed before or during the event. Persons suspected to be under the influence of drink or drugs will not be permitted to drive and no refund issued.
  - Any persons by way of unreasonable conduct either on or off the track can be asked to leave the premises without refund of any monies paid.
  - o The Manager/Race Directors decision is final.



#### **Event Terms and Conditions**

You must read and agree to the following declaration and paragraphs below which are designed to create a legally binding relationship in return for you being allowed to participate. If you are organising on behalf of a group, it is your responsibility to share this with fellow participants.

- By taking part I accept the risks involved including the risk of injury or death.
- I will ensure before taking part that I am happy that the venue and track is acceptable to me with regard to its features and physical layout (unless prohibited to do so).
- I declare that I am competent to take part.
- I am aware and accept that other participants will be on the course at the same time.
- I am not taking any drugs (prescribed or otherwise) that will impair my ability to take part.
- You confirm that you are not under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Drivers who are suspected to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol may be prevented from driving at the discretion of the circuit staff, for the safety of themselves and others. You will forfeit any fees paid.
- We reserve the right to refuse karting to anyone whom we consider a risk to the safety of themselves or anyone else on the premises.
- If you are acting in loco parentis for children that are not your own, by signing the waiver you guarantee that the children's' parents/ guardian is aware that they are participating in a motorsport and are aware of the risks involved.
- Spectators watch at their own risk. Children spectating must be kept under close supervision of a responsible adult at all times.
- Children under the age of 16, regardless of whether they are driving or spectating, must be accompanied by an adult who must remain on the premises for the duration of the child's stay and accept responsibility for them at all times.
- The minimum age for 'Arrive and Drive' is 14 years old. The minimum age for any race event is 16 years old. Proof of age may be asked for to confirm adherence to the age restrictions. Any driver who cannot provide suitable proof of age when requested will not be allowed to drive.
- You may bring/wear your own equipment provided it meets our minimum standards and is approved by a senior member of staff. If we feel that your gear may not meet our standards you will be required to use our equipment.
- Where necessary for privacy or religious purposes, you may request a private area for changing.
- Footwear must be trainers or similar. High heels, open toe, and shoes without adequate support are not permitted.
- You should not have items in your pockets.
- You should ensure jewellery is removed, long hair is tied back and long or false nails are not suitable.
- You confirm that you do not have a medical condition that would prevent you from driving on the road or taking part in any physical exercise.
- You have told us of any other medical conditions that may be of concern so we can advise you whether it is
  appropriate for you or others in your group to kart. These include, but are not limited to: heart conditions, back
  injuries, epilepsy, amputations/artificial limbs, hearing or sight impairments, or any form of mental or physical
  impairment.
- You must not drive if you are pregnant.
- You ensure that you watch the safety briefing fully. Anyone seen to not be paying attention to the brief will be made to re watch the safety brief and will get less time on track. You will abide to all rules given and follow any marshal's instructions. Any driver arriving after the start of the safety briefing will not be allowed to kart.
- We reserve the right to alter an event and the format if you are late on arrival for your booking.



- You understand that Mansell Raceway expects drivers to adhere to its rules to ensure the safety of all drivers, spectators and staff, and that failure to adhere to these rules will result in removal from the premises.
- We reserve the right to end sessions or remove drivers from the circuit early if we consider the safety of themselves or others is compromised.
- You will look after all safety equipment that you use and understand that damages must be paid for.
- When putting on race suits, you will take due care and consideration for the safety equipment. You understand that any damaged race suits will be paid for. Size guides are available in the suit room and from race control.
